STUDENT SUPPLY LIST 2017-2018

Recommended Items – These are items which students use in class. If parents wish, these items can be purchased over the summer for your child to begin the year.

****Please note that the best everyday prices can be found at Target, K-mart, Meijer, etc. Do not go to an office supply store, unless they have advertised sales.****

Transitional Kindergarten

Recommended:

2 boxes of Kleenex
2 rolls of paper towel
2 containers of disinfecting wipes
1 box of Ziploc bags (Girls-gallon size, Boys-Quart size)
1 pump bottle of hand sanitizer
4 pack of playdough (any colors)

Label the following with your child's name:

1 backpack or school bag (no wheels)
1 zippered pencil bag (no plastic boxes)
4 large glue sticks
1 pair of metal blunt tip Fiskar's scissors
3 boxes of 8 crayons
1 box of washable markers
4 large black dry erase markers
Shoebag/Ziploc bag with complete change of clothes in case of accidents. (Please remember to switch these out for the seasons or when needed.)

Donations:

Stickers, used children's books, games, old CD walkman that still works, general arts & craft supplies (glitter, pom-poms, pipe cleaners, googly eyes, buttons, etc.), prize box rewards (holiday erasers, small trinkets, fun pencils, etc.)

Kindergarten

Recommended:

1 backpack or school bag (no wheels)
4 large glue sticks
2 – 4 packs of Expo **small** dry erase markers
1 plastic folder w/pockets & clasps (no name on them, please)
1 plastic folder with ONLY pockets (no clasps)
1 spiral or composition notebook
1 box of band aids (dollar store brand is fine)

2 boxes of Crayola crayons (no more than 24)
1 coloring book for indoor recess
1 box of Kleenex
4 containers of playdough – any color
1 box of gallon-size Ziploc baggies
1 box of sandwich-size Ziploc baggies
1 container of baby wipes

Optional:

1 package of paper towel or napkins
1 package of clorox wipes
coffee filters

General arts & crafts supplies
(wiggle eyes, large pom-poms, buttons, glitter)

Snacks:

Rather than sending in an individual snack daily, we ask each family to send in a snack for the whole class to share once a month.

Snacks must be healthy for growing minds and bodies. Individually wrapped portions are easiest for us to pass out to the class. Some good suggestions are Granola or Cereal Bars, crackers like Cheez-its or goldfish, pretzels, pudding cups, applesauce or fruit cups. *Chips, cookies or other high-sugar foods are NOT considered to be healthy for everyday snacks.*

Grade One

Recommended:

2 boxes 24 ct. crayons
1 package of markers
1 package pink school erasers (not pencil toppers)
2 highlighters

1 pkg. colored pencils
4 large glue sticks
4 **black** Expo dry erase markers
1 box Kleenex

Label the following with your child's name:

1 spiral notebooks (child's choice)
1 composition notebook
Fiskar brand scissors
1 5oz. container of play dough

1 fun folder (child's choice)
1 soft-sided zipper pencil pouch (no plastic boxes)
1 coloring book (no stickers)
Backpack & lunch box

1 container of disinfecting wipes

Grade Two

Recommended:

1 small pencil box/bag	pink pearl erasers
3 plain, two-pocket vinyl/plastic folders (1 red, 1 green, 1 blue)	crayons
3 "Composition" notebooks	scissors (Fiskars work best)
10 Glue sticks (no liquid glue)	washable markers
2 large boxes of Kleenex	1 container of disinfecting wipes
1 pump bottle of hand soap	1 box sandwich ziplock baggies
1 deck of cards in a sandwich bag or plastic soap box (without face cards)	water bottle with pop top lid (no twist off caps)
Backpack and Lunchbox	
2-3 boxes of No. 2 pencils labeled with your child's name (sharpened if possible)	

Grade Three

Recommended:

2 boxes of Kleenex	1 bottle of anti-bacterial hand sanitizer
5 Highlighters	Hand soap
2 boxes of standard No. 2 pencils (Ticonderoga if possible)	Pencil bag/box
Scissors	4 Red checking pens
Erasers	Ruler (inches and centimeters)
Package of dry erase markers w/ a sock or eraser (for student's use)	Crayons
4 vinyl folders w/pockets (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, and 1 green)	Colored pencils
4 "wide-ruled" Spiral notebooks	4 glue sticks

***Optional: water bottles, MUST be wrapped in a sock, to keep from sweating on their desk**

****Please note that these supplies will NOT last all year and some may need to be refilled throughout the school year.****

Grade Four

Recommended:

1 2-inch 3 ring binder with pockets	4 different colored highlighters
3 Folders with 3 holes on the left side	2 black sharpie markers
1 pack of (12) No. 2 pencils sharpened (no mechanical)	2 Expo markers with dry eraser
1 Pencil sharpener with container to catch shavings	2 perforated wide-ruled notebooks
1 plastic zipper pencil bag (no boxes)	1 ruler with inches and centimeters
1 pack of (12) red pens	1 box of Ziplock Gallon Size storage bags
1 pack of 24 crayons	1 container of antibacterial wipes
1 pack of colored pencils-no markers	2 boxes of Kleenex
1 pair of scissors	1 roll of paper towel for Science
1 Thesaurus(not mandatory, but recommended)	1 Pair of Headphones or Ear Buds
1 Pocket Dictionary(not mandatory, but recommended)	3 medium erasers
1 pack of different colored lined 3 X 5 index cards	2 Jumbo glue sticks

Grade Five

Recommended:

Backpack (no wheels-do not fit in our small lockers)	Pencil bag (the boxes do not fit in the desks)
48 <u>Sharpened</u> pencils (replenish throughout the year) (no mechanical)	Colored pencils
1 pack of expo markers	Red ballpoint pens
4 duo-tang folders (the 2 pocket type, with center prongs)	4 spiral bound notebooks (70 pages, wide-ruled)
Crayola markers (fine tip)	Hand pencil sharpener with cover
Canvas tote bag (not a backpack – reusable bag/drawstring bag – OPTIONAL)	1 Composition notebook (see picture below)



(100 pages, wide-ruled)
